**THEME: DARING TO DREAM...BIG VISIONS FOR GOD! (1 CHRONICLES 4:9-10)**

*Church-wide 21 Days of Prayer and Fasting*

### **SCRIPTURE REFERENCE**

Matthew 6:5-18, Mark 9:29; Isaiah 58; Daniel 1:1-21

### **OVERVIEW**

Join us in the St. John Church Unleashed Season of Sacrifice & Spiritual Renewal: 21 Days of Prayer and Fasting, as we seek spiritual renewal, insight and guidance in areas of spiritual discipline, personal development, family, church, community and more. Our theme for the year is Dare to Dream...Big Visions for God! (1 Chronicles 4:9-10). Jabez prayed a personal prayer that had global impact. Dare to pray big prayers!

The 21 Days of Prayer and Fasting begins Wednesday, March 27 and ends Friday, April 19 (Good Friday). The 21 days do not include Sundays, although you can make adjustments according to your personal needs and expectations. However, the church-wide daily prayer call and sacrifice include weekends. The 21 Days of Prayer and Fasting ends with a Good Friday Service at 12:00 noon, followed by a Fish Fry Fellowship at the Grand Prairie Campus. There are four components of the 21 Days of Prayer and Fasting: Personal Quiet Time, Church-wide Prayer Call, Personal Sacrifice and Church-wide Sacrifice.

#### **(1) Personal Quiet Time:**

A daily personal devotion or quiet time is simply time set apart to spend with God. Plan to set aside time to spend with God everyday and be consistent. Quiet time is an important part of a Christian's everyday life to draw closer to God. It consists of practicing the spiritual disciplines of prayer, worship, Bible reading, meditating on God's Word, listening, journaling, silence, solitude, etc., with no distractions.

## **(2) Church-wide Prayer Call: 6:00 AM PRAYER CALL**

The 6:00 am Prayer Call begins Wednesday, March 27 and will continue daily (including weekends) ending on Friday, April 19, Good Friday. Each day there is a prayer focus and scripture. Each morning Pastor Davis and/or SJC representative will lead in devotion and prayer. After the Season of Sacrifice, the 6:00 am Prayer Call will resume weekly to every Wednesday.

## **(3) Personal Sacrifice:**

Choose your personal spiritual sacrifice. Your personal sacrifice may include a food fast, like the Daniel Fast, minimizing the use of technology/television/media or eliminating non-essential spending. Your personal sacrifice should be so impactful that in your suffering you are constantly reminded of the power and presence of God in your life to strengthen your relationship with God which is the focus of your sacrifice.

## **(4) Church-wide Sacrifice:**

As a church family, we will commit to a daily sacrifice during the 21 days of Prayer and Fasting.

- ❖ Monday – **Meatless Monday** – No eating meat, except for the meat of the Word. (Genesis 1:29, 9:3; 1 Corinthians 3:2)
  - ❖ Tuesday – **Turn-off Tuesday** – Unplug for at least 3 hours while awake and tap into the power of God. No TV, cell phones, computer, electronics, media, etc and replace with silence, solitude, prayer, journaling, etc. (Proverbs 4:25; 1 Corinthians 7:35, 10:13; Mark 4:19)
  - ❖ Wednesday – **Withhold Wednesday** – No non-essential spending of money. Instead spend time in prayer and in God’s Word. (Proverbs 21:20; Luke 12:33)
  - ❖ Thursday – **Thirsty Thursday** – No food. Water only (if medically able) from 6a-12noon. During this time develop a hunger and thirst for God’s Word. (Psalms 35:13; Matthew 4:1-3)
  - ❖ Friday – **Family Friday** – Unplug and spend time with family and friends. Play board games, walk in the park, pray together, etc. (Deuteronomy 6:4-9; 2 Timothy 3:15; Ephesians 6:4)
  - ❖ Saturday – **Saving Saturday** – No non-essential spending of money. Instead spend time serving others and sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ. (Proverbs 21:5; 1 Corinthians 16:2)
  - ❖ Sunday – **Sabbath Sunday** – Day of worship. Join us for worship at one of services 7a, 9a, 11a at Grand Prairie and 10a at Southlake Campus. (Hebrews 10:25; 1 Timothy 4:13; Matthew 18:20)

## PLANNING YOUR FAST

1. Seek the advice of your physician before you fast (Proverbs 14:28)
2. Make your commitment and determine the length (complete commitment form below) (Deuteronomy 23:23)
3. Have a clear vision for your prayer focus (Isaiah 58:5-6; Zechariah 7:5-6)
4. Prepare physically (Luke 14:28)
5. Fast in secret (Matthew 6:16-18)
6. Fast and pray in order to humble yourself and purify your worship (Ezra 8:21)
7. Prepare for opposition (Daniel 10:12-13)
8. Make "Quiet Time" a priority when fasting
9. Expect to hear God's voice through and according to His Word
10. If you fail, do not give into condemnation (Rom. 8:1)
11. Break the fast over several hours and days of light eating
12. Breakthroughs often come after, not during a fast (Daniel 10:3, 4)

## DAILY PRAYER FOCUS

### **Day 1: Wed March 27 - SPIRITUAL GROWTH – Commitment to the fast**

Lord God, we fast and pray today in total thanksgiving. We give You thanks in all circumstances. Our hearts and minds are fixed on Jesus Christ who is pure, loving, kind, holy, and gentle. “I will praise You with my whole heart...I will bow down toward Your holy temple and will praise Your name for Your love and faithfulness.” (Psalm 138:1-2) Father, we pray for strength and power from the Holy Spirit to sustain us in our commitment to this season of prayer and fasting.

**God’s Prayer Promise:** “We have this confidence before God and receive from Him anything we ask, because we obey His commands and do what pleases Him.” (1 John 3:21-22)

### **Day 2: Thu. March 28 - SPIRITUAL GROWTH – To be disciples of Jesus Christ**

Father God, as we fast and pray today, our desire is to be Your disciples, committed to equipping believers, enriching persons, evangelizing people and edifying missions; thus we will be in accordance with the mission of this church. As we recommit to the vision of our Pastor, help us to stay focused on Your will for us as Your ambassadors. “If anyone would come after Me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow Me. For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for Me will find it.” (Matthew 16:24-25).

**God’s Prayer Promise:** “But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who will see what is done in secret, and will reward you.” (Matthew 6:6).

### **Day 3: Fri. March 29 - SPIRITUAL GROWTH – For a closer walk with the Lord**

Father, we pray for a closer walk with You today. “You who seek God, may your hearts live.” (Psalms 69:32). ‘For I know the plans I have for you,’ declares the Lord. ‘Plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call upon me, and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me with all your heart. I will be found by you, declares the Lord.’ (Jeremiah 29:11-13). “Blessed are they who keep His statutes and seek Him with all their hearts.” (Psalm 119:34).

**God’s Prayer Promise:** “You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you to go and bear fruit - fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you whatever you ask in My name.” (John 15:16)

### **Day 4: Sat. March 30 - HOLINESS AND PURIFICATION – Confession and Repentance**

We fast with prayers of confession. “I confess my sins today, Father God. I desire to be holy as You are holy. Please cleanse me and restore me as I confess my sins. “Search me, O God and know my heart; try me and know my thoughts: And see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.” (Psalm 139: 23-24) Thank You for being faithful and just and forgiving my sins, purifying me from all unrighteousness.

**God’s Prayer Promise:** “If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just and will forgive our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.” (1 John 1:9)

**SUNDAY, March 31 - DARE TO DREAM...BIG VISIONS FOR GOD!: HANG IN THERE AND DON'T GIVE UP**

Lord, help us stand our ground and defend what we have gained, no matter how difficult it might be to do this. We know that with Your supernatural help, we can outlive and outlast the resistance. With Your Spirit's power working inside us, we know we can indefinitely and defiantly stick it out until the enemy realizes he cannot beat us and decides to retreat! Lord, we are well aware that events will occur in life that will tempt us to release the dreams You put in our hearts. So right now we ask You to fill us with the courage we need to refuse to let go of our dreams. Even though our minds and the circumstances around us may send signals that our dreams will never come to pass, we know that You are faithful to what You have promised. Help us wrap our arms of faith around Your promises and never let go until we see them come into manifestation! We pray this in Jesus' name!

**God's Prayer Promise:** "My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations, knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect ad entire, wanting nothing." (James 1:2-4)

"Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)." Hebrews 10:23

**Day 5: Mon. April 1 - HOLINESS AND PURIFICATION – Restoration and Renewal**

Father, we rest in You today and give You praise, honor and glory. Restore and renew us for this season of sanctification. "Whoever is wise, let him heed these things and consider the great love of the Lord." (Psalm 107:21, 43)

**God's Prayer Promise:** "Open wide your mouth and I will fill it." (Psalm 81:10a)

**Day 6: Tue. April 2 - HOLINESS AND PURIFICATION – Spiritual Focus**

Father God, we pray for spiritual cleansing and focus. Please make us an instrument of Your peace. Let us throw off everything that hinders us, and sin that so easily entangles. "Be ye imitators of God, therefore, as dearly loved children and live a life of love, just as Christ loved us and gave Himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God." (Ephesians 5:1-2)

**God's Prayer Promise:** "If you remain in Me and My words remain in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you." (John 15:7)

Today we fast and focus on Your invincible Truth, Father God. We pray that Your presence will abide with us in a special way today. We desire to have intimate fellowship with You. Touch our hearts in such a way that we will desire an even deeper fellowship with You and offer You our sacrifices of praise and worship.

**God's Prayer Promise:** "Then you will call upon Me and I will listen to you. You will seek Me and find Me when you seek Me with all your heart. I will be found by you," declares the Lord . . ." (Jeremiah 29:12-13).

**Day 8: Thu. April 4 - DIRECTION AND VISION – Divine Guidance**

Father, today we fast and pray, seeking Your guidance and blessing for our personal needs. Lord God, we know that Your Word is true; that You will supply all of our needs according to Your riches in glory (Philippians 4:19). Help us to stand in faith and to seek Your Kingdom and Your righteousness so that all we need can be added to us (Matthew 6:33). We thank You in advance for all of Your provisions and for every blessing, those seen and especially those not seen, as we walk by faith and not by sight. **God's Prayer Promise:** "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father." (James 1:17)

**Day 9: Fri. April 5 - DIRECTION AND VISION – Revelation**

We fast with prayers of worship. My soul magnifies the Lord! I stand in awe of Your greatness and power. I long for Your presence. "I spread out my hands to You; my soul thirsts for You like a parched land." (Psalm 143:6) I glorify Your name for You have done great things. I worship You!

**God's Prayer Promise:** "Call to Me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know." (Jeremiah 33:3)

**Day 10: Sat. April 6 - OUR FAMILIES – Marriages**

Father God, we fast and pray for the marriages & families within our ministry and in our community. May each husband love his wife as he loves himself and each wife respect her husband. We ask that You will fortify husbands and wives so that they will be able to stand against the schemes of the enemy that seek to destroy the unions of marriage You have established. "Your right hand, O Lord, is glorious in power. Your right hand, O Lord, dashes the enemy to pieces." (Exodus 15:6)

**God's Prayer Promise:** "And we receive of Him anything we ask, because we obey His commands and do what pleases Him." (1 John 3:22)

**SUNDAY April 7 – DARE TO DREAM...BIG VISIONS FOR GOD!: IT SHALL BE DONE**

Lord, we're so glad that we can be bold and straight to the point when we come into Your Presence. We are so thankful that You want us to boldly present our needs to You and expect You to answer our requests. Jesus told us to boldly ask, so it is right for us to do just that and You promise never to withhold any good thing from us! We pray this in Jesus' name!

**God's Prayer Promise:** "If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you." John 15:7

**Day 11: Mon. April 8 - OUR FAMILIES – Children and Teens**

Father, in the time we spend with you today, we want to ask for Your continued guidance, protection, and assistance in the lives of our children and teens. Protect them from evil. Keep them pure spiritually, emotionally, psychologically, and physically. Make them into that "Jacob Generation" (Psalm 24:6) who will seek Your face. Grant us as parents to raise them in the fear and the admonition of the Lord (Eph. 6:4).

Father, as You have aligned our hearts with Yours during this fast, we lift up future generations unto You. Allow our children and our children's children to walk in godliness and Kingdom purpose. **God's Prayer Promise:** "That the generation to come might know them, the children who would be born, That they may arise and declare them to their children, That they may set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, But keep His commandments." (Psalm 78:6-7)

**Day 13: Wed. April 10 - OUR CHURCH – Unity among membership**

Father, we pray as a church, asking that You will help us to be the church You have called for - A House of Prayer. We ask in faith, in the name of Jesus that You will convict our hearts to pray in the Spirit on all occasions, with all kinds of prayers and requests. We desire to always be alert and to pray for all the saints, especially for our Pastor and his family. "I pray also for those who will believe in Me through their message, that all of them may be one. Father, just as You are in me and I am in You, may they also be in Us so that the world may believe that You have sent Me." (John 17:20-21)

**God's Prayer Promise:** "Where two or three come together in My name, there am I with them." (Matthew 18:20)

**Day 15: Fri. April 12 - OUR CHURCH - Ministries**

Father God, we fast and pray today for all ministries of this church. Please strengthen every ministry to fulfill the mission of this church, to provide the enrichment, equipping, evangelizing, and the encouragement needed by our members and the community. Send more workers for the harvest, we pray. We ask that You will convict our hearts to serve You and Your people like never before.

**God's Prayer Promise:** "This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to His will He hears us. And if we know that He hears us - whatever we ask; we know that we have what we asked of Him." (1 John 5:14-15).

**Day 16: Sat. April 13 - NEEDS - Healing and Health**

Hear our prayer, O God, for the healing of illnesses and Diseases among us. Jesus, we thank You today; You were pierced for our transgressions and crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon You and by Your wounds we are healed. Lord, as we step out in faith to do something new, we realize there will always be obstacles that try to get in our way. Father, we pray that as they cry out to You, You will hear them and save them from their distress and pain. “Then they cried unto the Lord in their trouble, and He saved them from their distress. He brought them out of darkness and the deepest gloom and broke away their chains. (Psalm 107:13-14) We not only pray for the restoration of these persons, but we also pray for their families. Please heal souls, bodies, minds and relationships in the Name of Jesus. “But now, this is what the Lord says - ‘Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have summoned you by name; you are mine. When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; when you pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over you. When you walk through the fire, you will not be burned . . . For I am the Lord, your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior; you are my witnesses, “declares the Lord”, that I am God. Yes, from ancient days, I am He.” (Isaiah 43:1-3, 13).

**God’s Prayer Promises:** "The eyes of the Lord are in every place, Keeping watch on the evil and the good." Proverbs 15:3; “You may ask Me for anything in My name, and I will do it.” (John 14:14)

## **Day 21: Fri. April 19 - OUR COMMUNITIES – Global Communities, the World**

**God's Prayer Promises:** "The eyes of the Lord are in every place, Keeping watch on the evil and the good." Proverbs 15:3; "I tell you the truth, if you have faith and do not doubt, not only can you do what was done to the fig tree, but also you can say to this mountain, 'Go throw yourself into the sea', and it will be done. If you believe, you will receive whatever you ask for in prayer." (Matthew 21:21-22)

### **GOOD FRIDAY**

Lord, help us never to forget the price You paid on the Cross for our salvation. No one else could have taken our place. No one else could have paid the price for our sin. ### **SATURDAY, APRIL 20 - HOLY SATURDAY**

Lord, how can we ever adequately say thank You for all that You did for us at the Cross? We are so undeserving, but You came and gave Your life for us, taking away our sin and removing the punishment that should have passed to us. Had it not been for You, we would be eternally lost, so we just want to say thank You for laying down Your life that we might be free. Lord, open our eyes to those around us who are unsaved and in need of salvation. We know that You are trusting us to tell them the Good News that they can be saved. Please empower us strongly with Your Spirit, giving us the boldness we need to tell them the truth before it is too late. We pray this in Jesus' name!

**Scripture:** "Have you forgotten that when we were joined with Christ Jesus in baptism, we joined him in his death? For we died and were buried with Christ by baptism. And just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious power of the Father, now we also may live new lives. Since we have been united with him in his death, we will also be raised to life as he was. We know that our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives. We are no longer slaves to sin. For when we died with Christ we were set free from the power of sin. And since we died with Christ, we know we will also live with him.
